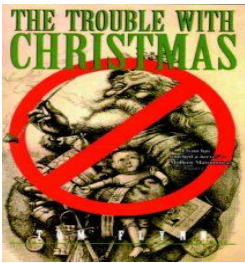
“Koj Puas Yog Tus Uas Yuav Los?”

Thov txoj koobhmoov txojkev hlub thiab txojkev haumxeb pub rau nej sawvdaws los ntawm Vajtswv uas yog peb Leejtxiv uas yog peb tus Cawmseej Tswv Yexus Khetos. Asmees.

**Lukas 7:19**, "He sent them to the Lord to ask, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we expect someone else?" – *Nws txib lawv mus cuag tus Tswv kom nug tias, "Koj puas yog tus uas yuav los, lossis peb yuavtsum tos lwmtus?"* (NIV). Nov yog Vajtswv Txojlus. (Cross-reference – Lukas 7:13, 20; 10:1; 11:1, 39; 12:42; 13:15)

Illustration "Christmas is not your holiday" (Show The Trouble with Christmas)

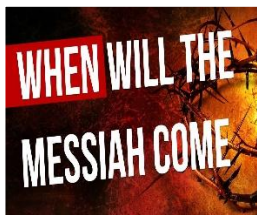


Lub sijhawm no ze zujzus rau lub koobtsheej “Christmas – *Hnub Yexus Yug.*” Muaj ibtug txivneej lub npe hu ua Tom Flynn sau "The Trouble with Christmas." Nyob rau hauv cov ntawv xovxwm tias "Ho, Ho, No. The Anti-Claus is Coming to Town" (*Wednesday Journal*, December 1, 1993). Lub ntsiab lus tseem ceeb ntawm cov ntawv xovxwm "If Jesus is not your Savior, Christmas is not your holiday – *Yog haistias Yexus tsi yog koj tus Cawmseej, Christmas tsis yog koj lub koobtsheej.*"

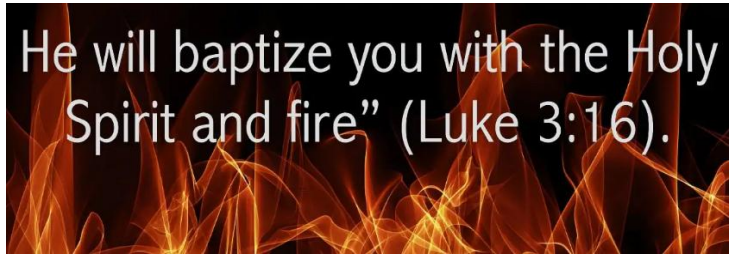

Yog haistias Christmas tsis yog cov tsis ntseeg lub koobtsheej, cov tibneeg uas niaj xyoo ua kev zoo siab muab khoomplig rau thaum Christmas yuav nug haistias "Thaum twg Christmas mam li los" rau cov tsis ntseeg Yexus Khetos ua lawv tus Camwseej.

I. Haivneeg Ixalayeess yeej ibtxwm tos ntsoov saib thaum twg lawv tus Vajtswv mam li los rau lawv haivneeg vim cov xibhwb (Daniyees 9:25-26; Yaxays 9:1-7; 11:1-10; Yelemis23:5-6) ntawm Vajluskub Qub twb qhia uantej lawm haistias tus Vajtswv yuav los kav lawv haivneeg yuav los. (Show When)



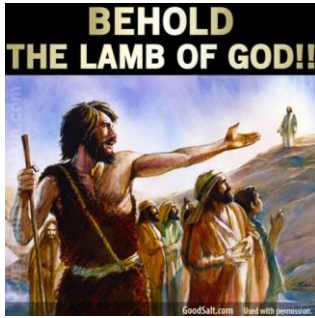
Yog li ntawd thaum Yauhas pib qhuab qhia tom roob mojsab qhua yog qhia kom haivneeg Ixalayeess yuavtsum npaj kho kev tos thiab lees lawv tej kev txhaum uantej tus Tswv los. Tus Tswv yog tus uas lawv tos ntsoov ntawm Vajluskub Qub yog tus Cawmseej, uas yog tus Mexiyas Yexus Khetos. Tiamsis txawm Yauhas qhia los haivneeg Ixalayeess tseem haistias "When will the Messiah come – *Thaum twg tus Mexiyas mam li los ?* (Show Luke 3:16)



Cov tubtxib uas raws Yauhas qab xav haistias Yauhas yog tus Mexiyas uas lawv tos tos los txog lawm. Yauhas thiaj li hais rau lawv haistias “I

baptize you with water. But one who is more powerful than I will come, the straps of whose sandals I

am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire – *Kuv muab nej ua kevcai ntxuav los ntawm dej. Tiamsis tus uas muaj hwjchim loj dua kuv yuav los, cov hlua ntawm nws cov khau khiab kuv tsis tsimnyog muab khi. Nws yuav muab nej ua kevcai ntxuav ntawm Vajtsujplig Dawbhuv thiab hluav taws.*" (Lukas 3:16). **(Show John 1:29)**



Thaum Yexus los hais kom Yauhas muab Yexus ua kevcai ntxuav tag, Yauhas thiaj li hais rau nws cov tubtxib haistias "...Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! – "...*Saib seb! Vajtswv tus Menyuum Yaj uas ris lub ntiajteb tej kev txhaum!*" (Yauhas 1:29). Vim los ntawm Yauhas txojkev qhuabqhia kom tibneeg lees lawv tej kev txhaum. Helauj yuav nws tus kwv Filipis tus pojniam Helaudia (Malakaus 6:17-29). Yauhas haistias txojkev ua txijnkawm li no yog ua txhaum. Vim Helauj thiab Helaudia tsis nyiam Yauhas, Helauj thiaj li txib kom nws cov tubrog muab Yauhas ntes kaw tsev lojcuj. **(Show John in prison)**



Thaum Yauhas raug ntes coj mus kaw ntawm tsev lojcuj lawm, Yauhas thiaj li txib nws cov tubtxib mus nug Yexus haistias "Are you the one who is to come, or should we expect someone else?" – "*Koj puas yog tus uas yuav los, lossis peb yuavtsum tos lwmtus?*" (Yauhas 7:19). Yexus thiaj li teb cov tubtxib ntawd tias "So he replied to the messengers, "Go back and report to John what you have seen and heard: The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is proclaimed to the poor – *Yog li ntawd,*

*nws thiaj teb rau cov tub txib haistias "Cia li rov qab mus qhia rau Yauhas tej yam uas koj tau pom thiab tau hnov: Cov dig muag pomkev, cov qhuav taws mus tau kev, cov neeg mob ruas raug ntxuavhuv, cov lag ntseeg hnov lus, cov neeg tuag tsa sawv rov los, thiab txoj xov zoo tau tshaj tawm rau cov neeg pluag."* (Lukas 7:22). Nov yog peb tus Cawmseej Tswv Yexus Khetos caw kom koj thiab kuv muaj txojkev cia siab rau nws. Txawm haistias lwmtus tseem muaj "doubt – xyem xyav" los koj txojkev ntseeg tseem nyob ruaj khovkho rau ntawm Yexus. **(Show John disciples asking Jesus)**

II. Cov kwvtij hlub thiab movtshua, Yauhas qhia txog txojkev leestxim ntawm kev txhaum kom tiam tibneeg ntawd tig rov los lees lawv tej kev txhaum thiab lees lawv tej txim lawv thiaj li yuav dim.



Yauhas yog tus xibhwb muaj npe nto moos lug uas tibneeg haistias nws yog ibtug xibhwb muaj meejmom siab. Yexus haistias "I tell you, among those born of women there is no one greater than John; yet the one who is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he – *Kuv hais rau nej tias, txhua tus uas yug los ntawm pojniam tsis muaj ibtug loj dua Yauhas; Tiamsis tus uas tsawg kawg hav Vajtswv lub tebchaws loj dua nws.*" Lukas 7:28). Qhov no txhais li cas? **(Show John doubt)**



Vajtswv txojlus hais rau koj thiab rau kuv haistias peb yog tus tsis muaj koob muaj npe. Peb tsis txawj qhuabqhia li lwmtus. Peb tsis muaj nyiaj muaj txiaj los peb yog tus tau txojkia nyob rau ntawm Vajtswv lub tebchaws los ntawm peb txojkev ntseeg Tswv Yexus Khetos ces peb yog tus loj dua. Lub ntiajteb no tseem tshuav coob leej ntau tus tsis tau Vajtswv lub tebchaws. Thaum Yauhas txib obtug tub txib mus nug Yexus haistias "Koj puas yog tus uas yuav los" txhais tau haistias Yauhas tseem txhawj muaj "doubt – xyem xyav" haistias nws txojkev

ntseeg puas yog txoj tseeb lost sis tseeb. Nws yog tus kho kev tos tus Tswv, ziaag no tus Tswv los lawm,

puas tseem yuav tos thiab los tsis tos lawm. (Show what kind of Messiah)



Haivneeg Henplais uas tsis lees txais yuav Yexus Khetos ua lawv tus Cawmseej tseem nij hnuv tos tus Cawmseej. Txawm Vajluskub Qub thiab Vajluskub Tshiab taw rau ntawm Yexus tias nws los theej tibneeg ntiajeb txojkev txhaum, cawm tibneeg ntiajeb ntawm lub txim khi rau ntawm dabntxwgnyoos saum tus ntoos khaublig tag lawm los lawv yeej tseem ua lub siab tawv qhawv tsis ntseeg Yexus. (Show siv yis Hmong)



Peb cov Hmoob los zoo sisthoj li no thiab. Ib txhia tseem tos ntsoov haistias Hmoob tus saub sivyig tseem yuav rov los cawm lawv ntawm dab lub hwjchim. Sivyig muab nws tej ntaj, tswbneeb, thiab lwmyam pov rau ntiajeb no lawm. Yog leejtwg nrhiav tau tus ntawv thiaj li yuav sawv ua txivneeb losyog pojneeb xwb. Tus nrhiav tsis tau tus ntawd yeej ua tsis tau ibtug tubtxib ntawm sivyig li.

III. Txawm Yauhas nug haistias “Koj puas yog tus tseem yuav los” los koj tsis txhob txhawj. Hnuv no Vajtswv caw koj los nrog nws sib raug zoo rau ntawm nws txojkev zamtxim thiab cawmdim los ntawm nws txoj koobmoov. Cia Yexus ua koj lub chaw cia siab thiab ruaj khov vim Yexus nrog nraim koj tsis pub txojkev phem los raug koj. Ntsia ntsoov rau ntawm Yexus txojkev hlub uas Yexus los rau lub ntiajeb no yog los ua tiav hlo kom koj muaj feem mus tau ntuj ceebtsheej. (Show Advent candle)



Lub “Advent – Lub Caij Yexus Los” yog kom koj npaj kho kev tos nws yog kho koj lub neej rau ntawm koj txojkev tseem muaj “doub – xyem xyav” lub ntiajeb txojkev txhaum. Ob lub limtiam tag los peb twb tais thawj obtug tswmcia xib “purple – liabxiav” (Love – Hlub, Hope – Cia Siab” lawm. Lub limtiam no peb taw ob tus nrog tus tswmcia thib peb xim “Rose –” txhais tias “Joy – Kajsia losyog Kev xyiv fab.” Nov lus Asmesliskas hu haistias “Gaudete Sunday.” Hnuv no cov ntseeg ua

koobtsheej hu haistias “Joy – Kajsia losyog Kev xyiv fab” txog Vajtswv tus Tub los rau lub ntiajeb los hloov thiab theej ntiajeb txojkev txhaum. Peb muaj kev “Joy – Kajsia losyog Kev xyiv fab” rau Yexus txojkev sawv ntawm kev tuag uas yog qhib ntuj ceebtsheej rau peb. Peb muaj kev “Joy – Kajsia losyog Kev xyiv fab” rau txojkev uas peb muaj feem cuam tau txojksia mus ibtxhis. Peb muaj kev “Joy – Kajsia losyog Kev xyiv fab” vim Yexus rov los koj peb mus nrog nws nyob ibtxhis thiab ibtxhis.

Koj yog tus ntseeg koj tsis tas yuav nug lolus haistias “Koj puas yog tus tseem yuav los” ntxiv lawm. Yexus twb los dhau 2000 xyoo los cawm koj thiab kuv ntawm kev txhaum, kev tuag, thiab dab lub hwjchim lawm. Cia ntseeg thiab cia siab rau Tswv Yexus Khetos vim Nws yog tus “... The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! – “... Tus Menyuum Yaj uas ris lub ntiajeb tej kev txhaum!” (Yauhas 1:29). (Show Revelation 22:12)



Cia li zoo siab, Yexus Khetos thiaj li haistias “Look, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to each person according to what they have done – Saib seb, Kuv yuav loss ai sai no! Kuv qhov khoom plig yog nrog kuv, thiab kuv yuav muab rau txhautus raws li lawv tau ua.” (Tshwmsim 22:12). Peb tos ntsoov hnuv koj los. Asmees. Thov kom Vajtswv txojlus pub rau peb sawvdaws totaub thiab tau nyob kajsia lug rau ntawm Tswv Yexus Khetos. Peb txhuatus uas yog Vajtswv cov menyuum, peb sawvdaws hais: Asmees

## Children Message Making A List For God



**Theme:** Prayer and Petition

**Object:** A shopping list

**Scripture:** "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." (Philippians 4:6, NIV).

Good morning, boys and girls. Have you ever gone to the store needing to buy several things? How do you remember them all? (*Let them answer*). That's right — a shopping list. Lists are a great way to help us remember.

God likes lists, also. Did you know that God likes you to make lists for him? (*Let them answer*). That's true. When the Apostle Paul talked to the people of Philippi, He told them they should keep lists of things they wanted to ask or share with God and then tell God about them when they prayed. That's a good idea. We could all keep lists of the things we want to discuss with God. Paul said that some of the things could be requests, which means things we need from God. There are a lot of things that only God can give, and we should let him know about them.

What would you ask from God if you could write out a list? (*Let them answer*). Those are some pretty good things to ask God for, and I hope you will think about them today and every day. Shopping lists are great, but you can only look for those things when you go to the store. When you make out lists to ask God, He promises to listen, hear, and answer your prayer. When you see other people taking out a shopping list, you can remember that you can ask God what you would like God to help you. God promises to answer our prayer in His own time.

**Prayer:** Dear God, thank You for hearing our prayers. May you answer them according to Your grace? In Jesus' name, amen.
