Served at Feed My Starving Children (FMSC)

Our conference participants did not just learned about prayers and that God answers prayers. They became the answers to many hungry children's prayers in Nicaragua. For just two hours, our conference participants packed 129 boxes of highly nutritional food to feed 77 children for one year. The value cost of these foods is \$6,130. The offering collected on August 14, 2015 at the conference was donated to FMSC.
