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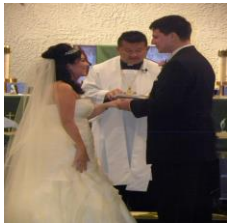
“Kuv Coglus”

Tenth Sunday after Pentecost  
St. Michael’s and Our Savior Lutheran Church  
7-29-18

Thov txoj koobhmoov txojkev hlub thiab txoj kev haumxeb pub rau nej sawvdaws los ntawm Vajtswv uas yog peb Leejtxiv uas yog peb tus Cawmseej Tswv Yexus Khetos. Asmees.

**Chivkeeb 9:9** I now establish my covenant with you and with your descendants after you – *Kuv coglus rau koj thiab koj cov xeebntxwv tomqab koj.*” Nov yog Vajtswv Txojlus. (Cross Reference – Chivkeeb 6:18; 9:8, 10)

Illustration “Covenant” (Show a wedding covenant – Lughnaj and Matthew)



Thaum twg tus pojniam thiab tus txivneej los sibyuav ua txijnkawm, nkawd coglus haistias, “Kuv, (Npe)\_\_\_\_\_, sawv timntsej timmuag ntawm Vajtswv thiab tagnrho cov povthawj no, yuav koj (Npe) \_\_\_\_\_, ua kuv tus pojniam; kuv yuav tu koj txij hnuvno mus rau yav tom hauvntej, txawm zoosiab losyog chimsiab, muaj losyog pluag, muaj mob losyog noj qab nyob zoo, kuv yuav hlub thiab ua zoo rau koj mus txog hnuv txojkev tuag los cais wb. Kuv coglus haistias kuv yuav ua ncaincees rau koj.” (Show type of contract)

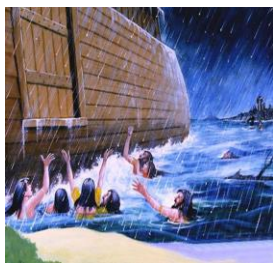


Thaum twg koj mus yuavtsev, koj kos koj lub npe rau daim ntawv coglus – contract haistias, koj yuav coglus them lub tsev ntawd mus txog 30 xyoo nrog rau “5% interest per

year – *Paj txhua xyoo*” koj mam li them tag. Koj mus yuav lub tsheb tshiab, koj kos npe coglus haistias, koj yuav ua 5 xyoo them. Thaum koj apply daim credit card, nyob rau daim application, covlus sau haistias, yog lub credit card company approved credit rau koj ces koj coglus them 14.5% thiab ib xyoo twg koj tau them \$50.00 ua “members – *tswvcuab*” rau lub credit card company.

I. Nyob rau Nau-es tiam, vim tibneeg ua kev txhaum thiab tsis mloog Vajtswv lus. Yog li ntawd, Vajtswv thiaj li tso dej los nyab lub ntiajteb thiab ua kom cov tibneeg nrog rau tej tsiaj tuag kom tag.

(Show the flood)



Vajtswv tsua cawm Nau-es tsevneeg nrog rau cov tsiaj uas Vajtswv xaivtseg lawm xwb. Chivkeeb 6:7 Vajtswv hais rau Nau-eestias, “..... “I will wipe from the face of the earth the human race I have created—and with them the animals, the birds and the creatures that move along the ground—for I regret that I have made them. – *Kuv yuav muab cov tibneeg uas kuv tau tsim no, thiab tej tsiaj loj tsiaj me, tej noog uas ya saum nruagntug ua kom puamtsuaj huv tibi mus, kuv tu siab heev vim kuv tau tsim lawv los.*” (Show Noah, dried land, and rainbow)



Tiamsis tomqab Vajtswv tso dej los nyab ntiajteb ua rau tibneeg nrog rau tsiaj tuag tag, tsua yog tshuav Nau-es tsevneeg thiab cov tsiaj uas Vajtswv xaivtseg lawm thiaj li muaj sia nyob xwb. Thaus dejqhuav tag lawm Vajtswv thiaj li rov coglus rau Nau-es tias, “I now establish my covenant with you and with your descendants after you and with every living creature that was with you—the birds, the livestock and all the wild animals, all those that came out of the ark with you—every living creature on earth. I establish my covenant with you: Never again will all life be destroyed by the waters of a flood; never again will there be a

flood to destroy the earth.” And God said, “This is the sign of the covenant I am making between me and you and every living creature with you, a covenant for all generations to come: I have set my rainbow in the clouds, and it will be the sign of the covenant between me and the earth. – *Txij no mus kuv coglus tseg rau koj thiab koj cov xeebntxwv, thiab txhuayam uas muaj sia, txhuayam noog, thiab txhuayam tsiaj uas nrog nej tawm hauv lub nkoj los Kuv coglus tseg rau nej haistias: Kuv yuav tsis tso dej los nyab txhuayam uas muaj sia kom puamtsuaj li zaum no, thiab nej yuav tsis nyab lub ntiajteb kom puamtsuaj li no ibzaug ntxiv lawm. Lub cim uas kuv coglus tseg mus ibtxhis rau nej thiab txhuayam uas muaj sia, mas yog kuv yuav ua kom muaj ib tug duabzaj sawv rau saum cov huab. Tus duabzaj ntawd yog lub cim uas kuv coglus tseg nrog tibneeg ntiajteb ntag.* (Genesis 9:9-13)

- II. Vajtswv haistias, “Kuv coglus” yog cov lus uas Nws tsis dag tiam thaus Nau-ees los txog niajhnuv nimno los lub ntiajteb no dej yeej tsis nyab ibzaug ntxiv li lawm. Vajtswv tseem cog lus ntau yam rau koj thiab rau kuv kom peb yuavtsum ua li Vajtswv hais peb thiaj li yuav tau txoj sia. (Show a contract)



Lolus cogtseg hais los ntawm ncauj losyog muaj daim ntawv “contract – *ntawv coglus*” tias koj yuavtsum ua li hais. Nyob rau lub ntiajteb no peb txhuatus muaj cov lus cogtseg rau ntau yam hauv peb lub neej. Peb yuav tsheb, peb yuav tsev, peb mus txais tus txheeb tus ze los peb yeej muaj lolus cogtseg haistias, peb yuav them tej ntawd rov rau tus uas koj txais ntawd. Peb ua neej nyob zoo nkaus li peb tsua muaj cov lus cogtseg mus tag li hauv peb lub neej. Tej tus nws yuav ua li cov lus cogtseg. Tej tus yuav tsi ua li cov lus cogtseg. Vim lub ntiajteb no, cov lus cogtseg tsua yog hais los ntawm lub ncauj los ntawm tibneeg. Nws yuav tsis muaj nyob mus ibtxhis. (Show debt)

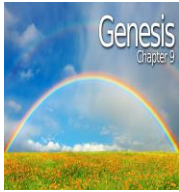


Peb Hmoob nyiam siv lolus cogtseg koj los hais li no rau thaus lub ntees tuag. Cov xyomcuab ua lub ntees tuag yuav hais rau pejxeem sawvdaws haistias, “Yog tus txivtsev no tshuav leejtwg nujnqi, nej yuavtsum los hais thiab nqa povthawj los li 5 nasthi tomntej no. Yog leejtwg tsis los hais thiab tsis nqa tau povthawj los tias peb tus txheeb tus ze no tshuav leejtwg nqi ces muab hais tau haistias, tus tuag lawm tsis tshuav leejtwg nqi.” Yog leejtwg tsis hais dabtsis ces tej nujnqi ntawd tsis tshuav li lawm. Thaus nej pom li no, puas “make sense – *totaub*” tias txojkev ua li ncajnrees los tsis ncajnrees? Nov yog tibneeg txojkev koj noj koj ua.

Txawm zoo tsis zoo los tibneeg haistias, nov yog tej lus coglus tseeb uas tau hais lawm. Yog leejtwg tsis hais ces tag, tsis muaj koj rov los hais lawm.

III. Tiamsis Vajtswv cov lus cogtseg rau Nau-es rau koj thiab rau kuv tsis yog zoo li tibneeg ntiajteb coglus. Ibtiam dhau ibtiam. Vajtswv yeej coglus rau tibneeg ntiajteb tias nws los cawm tibneeg kom tibneeg tsis txhob raug txojkev txiavtxim poob mus rau ntujtawg los ntawm Nws tus Tub Yexus Khetos.

Vajtswv foom koobhmoov rau Nau-es tsev tibneeg kom lawv huamvam mus puv thooob ntiajteb. Tiamsis txawm tibneeg huamvam rov mus puv thooob ntiajteb lawm los tibneeg tseem niajnhub ua txhaum. Tiamsis Vajtswv tsis tso dej los nyab lub ntiajteb. Chivkeeb tshooj 11:9 Vajtswv ua kom nyias hais nyias yam lus. Dhau ntawd los txog thaus uas Vajtswv pom haistias, yog Vajtswv tsis tso Vajtswv tibleeg Tub los theej tibneeg txojkev txhaum ces tibneeg yuav tsis dim ntawm txojkev txhaum uas yog lub txim mus ibtxhis thiab ibtxhis. (Show different picture)



Vajtswv coglus rau Nau-es los ntawm tus “rainbow – duabzaj” tias nws yuav tsis tso dej los nyab ntiajteb ntxiv lawm. (Chivkeeb 9:13) Vajtswv coglus tias Anplahas yuav yog txhuatus tus yawgkoob – nws covxeebntxwv yuav ntau ibyam li cov hnuqbub saum ntuj thiab cov xuabzeb ntawm ntug dej hiavtxwv. (Chivkeeb 22:17) Vajtswv coglus tias

tus uas ntseeg Nws tus Tub tus ntawd yuav tsi tuag tiamsis tau txojhia mus ibtxhis thiab ibtxhis. (Yauhas 3:16) Vajtswv thiaj li txib Yexus los tuag theej ntiajteb txojkev txhaum.

Cov kwvtij hlub thiab movtshua, Vajtswv coglus los ntawm Nws txojkev cawmdim. Hnubno koj puas ntseeg Vajtswv txojlus coglus? (Show 2 Peter 3:7)

### God Will Destroy Earth Again

“The heavens and the earth that now exist are being preserved by the same command of God in order to be destroyed by fire. They are being kept for the day when godless people will be judged and destroyed.”  
2 Peter 3:7 TEV



Vajtswv yuav tsis tso dej los nyab ntiajteb no ntxiv lawm tiamsis Nws colus tias, “By the same word the present heavens and earth are reserved for fire, being kept for the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly. But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything done in it will be laid bare – Los ntawm tib lolus rau tiam tamsim no ntawm ntuj thiab lub ntiajteb uas ceev cia rau hluavtaws,

uas yog muab khaw cia rau hnub uas txiavtxim thiab puamtsuaj rau cov tibneeg ua phem. Tiamsis hnub uas tus Tswv los zoo ib yam li tus tubsab. Lub ntuj yuav ploj ntais nrog suab qeeg nkaws; txhuayam yuav raug puamtsuaj los ntawm hluavtaws kub, thiab lub ntiajteb thiab txhuayam nyob rau hauv yuav liab qab huv tibi. ” (2 Petus 3:7, 10) Txhuayam uas Vajtswv hais, Vajtswv yeej ua tiav hlo lawm.

(Show God covenant)



Koj cia li cia siab thiab ntseeg Nws txojlus, vim los ntawm koj txojkev ntseeg, Koj yuav nyob kajsiaib lug vim koj twb dim ntawm txhuayam hauv ntiajteb no lawm. Los ntawm Vajtswv txojlus cogtseg tias, “Kuv coglus” “Kuv hu koj ntawm txojkev tsaus ntujnti los rau ntawm qhov kaj.” (1 Petus 2:9) Koj los muaj kev ncaincees dawbhuv rau ntawm Vajtswv. (Efexaus 1:4) Koj twb yog Vajtswv cov menyuam. (Kalatias 3:26) Vajtswv cog lus tias, nws yuav rov los sai sai thiab yuav los koj koj mus nrog nws nyob tau txojhia mus ibtxhis thiab ibtxhis. (Tshwmsim 22:12) Cia li cia siab rau Nws txojlus cogtseg tias, “My covenant - Kuv Coglus.” Asmees.

# Children Message

## A Rainbow Promise



**Theme:** God is faithful in keeping his promises

**Object:** A wedding band

**Scripture:** "I establish my covenant with you: Never again will all life be cut off by the waters of a flood; never again will there be a flood to destroy the earth... I have set my rainbow in the clouds, and it will be the sign of the covenant between me and the earth." Genesis 9:11, 13 (NIV)

I'm sure that everyone has seen a ring like this one. (hold up wedding band) (*Let them answer*) It is a very special kind of ring. Do you know what kind of ring it is? It is a wedding ring. It is a very simple ring. It is very special because it is a reminder of a promise that is made when a couple gets married. On the day that they are married, a husband and wife make a promise that they will love and stand faithfully beside one another "for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health, for as long as they live." Each of them wears a wedding band as a reminder of that promise that they made. The ring also tells everyone who sees it about the promise that the couple made.

We all make promises, don't we? You might promise your mother that you will clean your room and do your chores before you go out to play. Or you may promise to keep a secret told to you by your best friend. You may promise to return something that you borrowed from a neighbor.

Has anyone ever broken a promise they made to you? (*Let them answer*) How did that make you feel? What did you say? You were probably very disappointed and said something like, "But you promised!" Sometimes we aren't very good at keeping our promises.

God makes promises. Our Bible lesson today is about a promise that God made to a man named Noah. I'm sure that you know the story of how God sent a great flood to destroy the earth because the people had become so wicked and evil. He destroyed everything he had created except for two of every kind of bird and animal and Noah and his family. He spared them because Noah was a good and righteous man who walked with God.

After the flood waters went down and Noah's family and all the animals could leave the ark, God made a promise to Noah. He promised Noah that he would never again destroy the whole earth with a flood. Then he did something to remind Noah of that promise. He placed a rainbow in the sky and he said to Noah, "I have set my rainbow in the clouds, and it will be a sign of the promise between me and all life on the earth." God said that every time he saw the rainbow, he would remember the promise that he made.

God has kept that promise, hasn't he? God keeps all of his promises. In fact, the Bible says that, "No matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ." (2 Corinthians 1:20) The next time you see a rainbow, remember the promise God made to Noah, and remember that just as he has kept that promise, he keeps all of his promises.

Dear Father, we are thankful that you are faithful to keep your promises. Help us to be faithful in keeping ours.
