About the Hmong

The Hmong is an ethnic minority group that has no country of their own. Their history, culture, tradition, and religious practices could be traced all the way back to the Old Testament. With centuries of migration, they lost knowledge and faith in the triune God. They became animists. Currently, it is estimated that there are as many as 18 million Hmong around the world. Approximately two million of them are living in Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, and Vietnam; with less than ten percent of them being Christians. For the past six years, the Lo family has been stationed in Thailand and traveled throughout Southeast Asia to engage the Hmong with the Gospel. The Lo family is the only LCMS' members that are working specifically with the Hmong in Southeast Asia on a long-term basis. In this report you will learn about the fruits of their labor from July 2021to June 2022. May you be blessed by what you read in this annual report, and may it move you to continue partnering with the Lo family to impact the Hmong in Southeast Asia for eternity.
