

## LCMS Hmong Ministry

Great News!

First, the Hmong Mission Society LCMS is now officially a Recognize Service Organization (RSO) of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod as of August 14, 2017. **What is a Recognized Service Organization (RSO)?** It is a tax-exempt service organization that is independent of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) but whose operations foster the mission and ministry of the church, whose program activities are in harmony with the programs of the Synod, and who agrees to respect and not act contrary to the doctrine and practice of the Synod, may apply for RSO status with the LCMS. Such organizations that meet these criteria, have applied for, and subsequently have been granted recognized status are RSOs. LCMS Hmong Ministry can move forward with using the maroon LCMS Cross on the Hmong Mission Society logo and continue its work of making disciples to all nations.



Second, it took 11 years for the New Hmong Hymnal “Phoo Ntawv Hawm Hab Qhuas Vaajtswv” to be published and delivered in December 2015. In August 2017, we have made the piano instrumental track that can be used to play during worship services. Many of our Hmong Ministries do not have a piano player so this is a great tool that can be used during worship services. They are 263 hymns but the CD has 265 piano tracks because it includes the “Holy Holy Holy—Dlawbhuv Dlawbhuv Dlawbhuv and Lamb of God—

Vaajtswv Tug Mivnyuas Yaaj.” May the honor and glory go to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

The Hmong Ministry had come a long way since 1978. Today, we have twenty three pastors with eighteen Hmong Ministries in nine districts of the LCMS. With seven (7) Master of Divinity degree (M. Div), three Distant Education Leading to Ordination (DELTO), twelve (12) Ethnic Immigrant Institute of Theology (EIIT), one (1) Colloquy (CTS) and two of the ordained pastors have a Doctor of Philosophy degree (Ph. D) and Juris Doctor degree in Law (J.D.). Two ordained pastors graduated from Concordia Theological Seminary (CTS) from Ft. Wayne, IN and

The rest of the pastors are from Concordia Seminary (CSL) from St. Louis, MO. Two lay leaders from Our Redeemer Lutheran Church—Hmong Ministry in Chugiak, Alaska have just finished the Deacon Licensing

Qualification in the Hmong Language. They will be interviewed by the Northwest District and they will be commissioned as Deacon to serve the Hmong Ministry and to lead or assist the Anglo worship services at Our Redeemer Lutheran Church. Hmong ministry continues to grow in God's grace.


The Hmong Lutheran Women is schedule to have a women retreat for the Hmong Ministry in 2018. Further information is forth coming.
