




# LINC Twin Cities


LINC Twin Cities' mission and goal is "*To equip Christians to live in relationship and partnership with their communities encompassing their*

I believe to achieve this missional development, change must take place at the individual and congregational levels.



◆ **The Word of God:** Christians must **Get Into The Word of God.** They must become serious Bible students. Each person must have their own Bible study time and attend Bible study groups beyond Sunday Bible classes. LINC-TC will help pastors lead more life-changing Bible studies. Bible study must become a matter of the heart, rather than just a matter of the head. Each Christian must study the Bible to be transformed rather than just to understand the wisdom of God. (John 15:4-11).

◆ **LIVE OUT THE WORD: Individual level:**

**PRAYER:** LINC-TC will assist Pastors to teach their members about the power and promise in prayers. Prayers must become daily conversations with God, not just asking Him for things they need. (Matthew 7:7-12).

**Join Jesus in His Mission:** LINC-TC will assist Pastors to teach and train their members to become missionaries in their daily lives. They are the first Gospel the lost (neighbors, friends, co-workers, relatives, etc...) will see; and through them is where the lost will experience the grace, mercy and forgiveness of the Lord Jesus Christ. Christians are to live in relationship with the people that the Lord puts around them. (1 Peter 2:9).

## GPS Marriage Event

LINC Twin Cities co-sponsored the GPS (God’s Plan for Successful) Marriage Event on Feb. 16, 2014 with the MNSD Hmong Ministries. Rev. Dan Keinath of South Shore Lutheran Church in White Bear Lake, MN was the keynote speaker. There were 48 married couples in attendance.



**Way of the Cross Living:** LINC-TC will assist those Christians who are passionate about living sacrificially for Christ and become blessings to others so they can simply live. This is about denying the things of our flesh, taking up the cross, and following Jesus. When our Christian brothers and sisters live life this way, ministries will be blessed. (Matthew 16:24-25).
