Who are the Hmong?

During our visits to different congregations, people kept asking us, “Who are the Hmong?” Western anthropologists described the Hmong as an ethnic group of people living mostly in Asia with an estimated population of 18 million. They claimed that the Hmong have a four thousand year old culture that ties to animist religion. However, with a good understanding of the Hmong culture, religion and knowledge of the Bible, one can see that the Hmong was a group of people that knew the triune God. This is why they are still celebrating the Passover, eating of the unleavened bread and commemorating the crossing of the Red Sea and the Jordan River annually. With long histories of migration and sin, they have departed from the triune God. It is estimated that in Southeast Asia alone, there are over two million Hmong, and the majority of them are not yet Christians. Our family is now called to serve the Hmong in Southeast Asia and we are inviting you to partner with us. Our goal is to raise \$1 from each member of the 2.1 million LCMS members. This will help us to engage the Hmong with the Gospel for years to come.
