Love Our Enemies and Pray for Our Persecutors

During the months of February and March, we were busy with theological training, service projects, witnessing, conducting a wedding and traveling to visit our mission churches. These ministries took a lot of our time and therefore, we did not have time to put together a newsletter to update you about the Lord's work we did in February. In addition, the coronavirus concern has also disrupted our ministry work. However, we thank the Lord for continuing to use us in His work of seeking and saving the lost. Recently, we visited our evangelist's long lost relatives in a very remote Hmong village. While in the village, we were able to witness and share the Gospel to many people, including some of the village leaders. The Lord granted us the opportunity to baptize four individuals, including a mother and her infant son. It was the first infant baptism in the village. Furthermore, a grandmother also confessed Jesus as her Lord and savior but her husband refused to allow her to be baptized. We prayed for her and assured her that with her confession and faith in Christ, she is a child of God. We will continue to share the Gospel with her family, especially her husband, and pray for the Holy Spirit to bring them to faith.

While in the village, we were told that there was a Hmong Christian family in the village. We went to visit them and asked if we could worship with them on Sunday. They were surprised to see us and with great joy, invited us to hold worship at their home. They also shared with us that there once were many Hmong

Christian families in the village, but because of persecutions they all returned to practicing animistic religion again. Some of the persecutors were the relatives of our evangelist. For the next two days, we spent time with the evangelist's relatives and witnessed the love of Christ to them and shared with them what it meant to be Christians—to believe in Jesus Christ and to love your neighbors. They asked many questions with great interest. We realized that it was the Lord that brought us to visit and witness the Gospel to the relatives. As Jesus says in Matthew 5, we are to love our enemies and to pray for those who persecuted us (vs. 44). We pray for the Lord to continue to use us to witness to these people. May the Holy Spirit grant them faith to believe in Christ, so that they can be used, like the Apostle Paul, to be the Lord's evangelists in His work of seeking and saving the lost.
