## Jesus Is Our Vaccine for COVID-19

We all are impacted by the coronavirus around the world at different intensities. While in Southeast Asia, there are less confirmed cases and deaths reported vs. the United States. When we saw the numbers of confirmed COVID-19 cases and deaths increasing in the US, we fell to our knees and asked the Lord for mercy. The Lord spoke to US in Psalm 91 that *"He is our refuge and fortress"*. No pestilence or plague can come near us because His angels will guard our ways. This gives us comfort and relief knowing that the Lord is our vaccine for the COVID-19.

While our family stays home, we did a lot of work through the use of the Internet. We taught the word of God and held church services on-line with our Hmong pastors and their church members in Southeast Asia. Fung put together two books in the Hmong language on our Lutheran doctrines and confessions. Kalia teaches her English and Social Studies classes with Mont Forth College on-line. ### Baptisms:

During this time of shut-in, for fear of contracting coronavirus, the Gospel is still moving forward without any hesitation. Working in partnership with our Hmong pastors in Southeast, in April alone **47 individuals were baptized**. The people used their staying home time to study the Word of God through a book that Fung had put together

on Lutheran doctrines and confessions. It is a wonderful time to witness the Gospel .

### A Special Need Request:

In the middle of March, one of the things that we heard from our relatives, supporters, and the media was that people in the US worried about not having enough toilet papers. It was strange for our church members in Laos to hear about this concern. In Laos most of the people are using water to wash themselves after they used the toilet, so not having toilet paper was not a big concern. For one of our church groups in Laos, their main concern is not having any clean water for cooking and drinking. The water well in the village is filled up with sand. The water they are getting from the water well is filthy and dirty. It is not even good enough for bathing, but only use for the toilet.

After four months of dealing with the coronavirus, toilet papers are still available in almost every home in America. However, our church members in the village of Hakhian, Laos still have no clean water for cooking and drinking. They are praying for a new water well. They also need a new water pump and water tank to collect the water for the people to use. The cost of everything will be **\$1,000.00**.
