During the month of April our family continued to travel and visit churches in Minnesota. It is always a joy and a blessing to share the Lord's word and His work in Southeast Asia with our supporters, especially during this season of Easter. resurrection of our Lord moves us to boldly proclaim the Good News around the world. A good example of this was how the Lord used Laozong, one of our Hmong pastors in Southeast Asia, to witness the Gospel to a couple at the hospital. As Laozong and his wife were on their way to minister to two new congregations up on the mountains, Laozong became sick. His wife took him to the hospital in the city. After careful examination of Laozong's condition, he was told that he had some blood clots in his heart. He needed to undergo a surgical procedure right away to save his life. Without any money, the family called Fung. Fung sent some funds to help with the surgery. The procedure was successful and one day later Laozong was in his bed trying to recover. Has very weak and unable to talk. He was just lying in his bed. His wife decided to go and buy some food in the market. When she came back, Laozong was not in his bed. She quickly searched for him and found that he was already up and visiting with two other patients in the hospital. Laozong was telling them about Jesus. Laozong had no idea how he got the strength to get up and walk over to the two patients next door. But he knew that he wanted to tell them about Jesus, so he just got up from his sick bed and walked over to the other room. When Laozong's wife walked into the room where Laozong was still telling them about Jesus, he told his wife to go out and rent a hotel room for them. She asked him why? Laozong told her that "I need a room away from the hospital's staff so I can do the Lord's work". She went outside to the next street and rented a room. She came back to the hospital and told Laozong that a hotel room has been secured. Laozong asked the two patients to go with him to the hotel room. Once they were in the hotel room, Laozong continue to tell them about what it means to be Christians. After couple hours of witnessing to the couple, they accepted Christ as their savior. Laozong then told them about the power and promise in baptism. They decided to be baptized. So Laozong asked his wife to get a bowl of water from

Her husband did not even have the strength to talk earlier and now he stood before the couple telling them about Jesus and baptizing them as though Laozong had not even been sick. How God used Laozong was a good example of what the Apostle Paul says, "For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain" (Philippians 1:21). Our family is blessed to have the opportunities to work in partnership with the Hmong pastors and evangelists in Southeast Asia.
