In December, it was a time for our family to return to the US for an indefinite furlough because of insufficient financial support coming to keep our family in Thailand. Therefore, it was a time of sadness that we had to leave the people we served. However, it is a joy knowing that we will continue to engage the Hmong in Southeast Asia with the mission of God from the US, because Immanuel is with us always.

While making preparation to leave Thailand, we continued serving the Lord by visiting our church members in Thailand and teaching online. However, the local authority interrupted one of the trainings online on the third day. So, we had to stop the training. The final visit with our church members in the mountains of Thailand was a joy. We thank the Lord for our flights back to the US. There were no delays with any of our flights and the health precaution procedures at the airports were not as bad as we expected. On December 21st our family arrived in Minnesota. Currently, our family is quarantining at our home in Hugo, Minnesota until January 5, 2021. It was a joy to arrive on time to celebrate Christmas with our daughter Faith and son-in-law Steven.

For the next couple of weeks we will be relaxing and spending time in prayers to seek the Lord’s wisdom and well for how we will connect with our supporters for 2021. Even though our family will be working from the US, the Lord’s mission work in Southeast Asia with the Hmong is growing. They are in need of resources to start new ministries and plant new churches. We thank the Lord for granting Fung the opportunities to finish and publish three books to help equip the Hmong to engage in the mission of God. All these books are in the Hmong language. The first book is a systematic understanding of

our Lutheran doctrines and confessions. The second book is about church members and pastors’ duties and responsibilities. The third book is a practical understanding of the Christian life from both Biblical and Hmong cultural perspectives. These three books are blessings for our online teachings. Without them, it would be very difficult and ineffective to teach online. We are seeking funding to help the printing of these books to make them available to the Hmong people in Southeast Asia and around the world. They are among the few written resources in the Hmong language for the Hmong people from Lutheran doctrines and confessions of the Christian faith.
