This Kind of Demon Can Come Out Only by Prayer

During the month of January we hosted two different groups of volunteers and visitors. One of the groups helped teach English with Kalia at Payap University to forty-four Korean students from Korea. The other group consisted of Kalia's father, mother, uncle, and aunt. They came to visit the Lord's ministries and us. On one particular visit to one of our mission churches a woman came to ask for prayer for her health condition. With many of the church members and the pastor we

gathered around her and many other individuals who also requested prayers. Suddenly, toward the end of our prayers, this one lady started to shake uncontrollably. One of the church members said, "The woman is being demon possessed!" She continued to

shake, cough, and jump uncontrollably. All we could do was continue praying for her by asking the Lord Jesus Christ to cast out whatever demon haunting the woman. *Here is a short video of the exorcism prayer:* <https://vimeo.com/390948499>. After about ten minutes the woman cough, threw up, and shouted, "Get out of me. I don't want you. I am a child of God. I want Jesus and worship Him only." She was exhausted. We took her into the church building and had her lay on a mat on the floor. After a long rest the woman got up to hold her baby and talk to the other ladies. She explained to them that it was like someone was choking her. Her pastor told us that the first time he tried to cast out the demon from her, she told him that the demon was a soldier that died in the battlefield near her village many years ago. He is a lost soul that

doesn't know where to go. When she heard that Jesus is the Lord of all things and that He can help her, she became a believer. She was baptized in December.

After this episode, Fung kept thinking about the time when the disciples could not cast out a demon from a young man in Mark 9; "A man in the crowd answered, 'teacher, I brought you my son, who is possessed by a spirit that has robbed him of speech. Whenever it seizes him, it throws him to the ground. He foamed at the mouth, gnashes his teeth and becomes rigid. I asked your disciples to drive out the spirit, but they could not'" (Verses 17 & 18). Jesus replied, "This kind can come out only by PRAYER" (Verse 29).. All we could do for the woman was pray by asking Jesus to cast out the spirit

that seized her. We need to continue to pray for her and many others who are being possessed by many different kind of spirits, especially those who are possessed by the spirit of unbelief in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. Your missionaries: Fung, Kalia, and Mercy Lo.
